 - a. RESPONSE: Please provide multiple options.
- 7. Will the evaluation be based on lowest bid or any other quantitative or qualitative metric? Can they be described?
 - a. RESPONSE: Bid evaluation is based on bid criterion.

- 8. What is the projected date for selecting the contractor?
 - a. RESPONSE: Bids will be opened publicly on 4/24/19.
