14. WARRANTY/GUARANTEE/INDEMNITY

14.1 Warranty/Guarantee

14.1.1 The Contractor shall obtain and preserve for the benefit of the District, manufacturer's warranties on materials, fixtures, and equipment incorporated into the Work.

14.1.2 In addition to guarantees required elsewhere, Contractor shall, and hereby does guarantee and warrant all Work furnished on the job against all defects for a period of ~~ONE (1)~~ **TWO (2)** year after the later of the following dates, unless a longer period is provided for in the Contract Documents:

14.1.2.1 The acceptance by the District's governing board of the Work, subject to these General Conditions, or

14.1.2.2 The date that commissioning for the Project, if any, was completed.

At the District's sole option, Contractor shall repair or replace any and all of that Work, together with any other Work that may be displaced in so doing, that may prove defective in workmanship and/or materials within a ~~ONE (1)~~ **TWO (2)** year period from date of completion as defined above, unless a longer period is provided for in the Contract Documents, without expense whatsoever to District. In the event of failure of Contractor and/or Surety to commence and pursue with diligence said replacements or repairs within ten (10) days after being notified in writing, Contractor and Surety hereby acknowledge and agree that District is authorized to proceed to have defects repaired and made good at expense of Contractor and/or Surety who hereby agree to pay costs and charges therefore immediately on demand.

Request for information:

- Item 1-1:** **Question 1:** Is the Short ES Early Childhood Education ("ECE") Development Project a summer project? The Specs call for 90 day construction time, but don't have any information on start and finish milestones. Is there a drop dead finish date based on the school calendar?
Response 1: Specification Section 01 32 13 Scheduling of Work, lists a Construction Start Date of April 15, 2024 and a Final Project Completion date of July 14, 2024.
- Item 1-2:** **Question 2:** The SPECS show "if applicable" for a Project Labor Agreement in 1.1.14.17. Is there a Project Labor Agreement for this project?
Response 2: This project does not have a Project Labor Agreement.
- Item 1-3:** **Question 3:** I work with Buhler Commercial a local General Contractor in the bay area. We are potentially interested in bidding on the Short Elementary School ECE Development Center Project and had one quick question after reviewing the project manual. In the instructions to bidders there is a mention of needing to meet a good faith effort for DVBE participation on the project and certifying this compliance with a DVBE Certification form that is said to be attached. Going through the rest of the documents, I could not find this form, could you please send over this form at your earliest convenience along with any further information on what we would need to do in order to meet the good faith effort

(usually there is a deadline for how many days we have to advertise the bid before the bid due date for DVBE). The form is listed as section 00 45 46.02 but that section is not present in the project manual from your website.

Response 3: Specification Section 00 45 46.02 Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Participation Certification added. (attached)

Item 1-4: Question 4: I have a question regarding the fence and gate scope on your 'Short Elementary School Early Childhood Education ("ECE") Development' project in San Rafael, CA.

- [Regarding the chain link fence.] The plan details (L3.1) call for 2" mesh with no mention of privacy slats while the specifications (32 13 13-2.2-B) calls for *"2" or 1" diamond mesh (or sized as required for privacy slat inserts)"*.
 - Can you please confirm whether or not these new fences are to receive privacy slats? If these new fences are to receive privacy slats, would you allow for the installation of **pre**-slatted mesh (which is typically available in 3-1/2" diamond opening). This would be the most economical option while achieving the same function and aesthetic as the far less typical smaller diamond slatted material.

Response 4: Pre-slatted is acceptable for the fencing and gate surrounding the existing electrical enclosure only.

Item 1-5: Question 5: Section 102800 - Toilet Accessories Issue:
1) The following items are specified & not shown. Please confirm these items are not needed on this project: Bobrick Sanitary Napkin Disposal -270

2) The Following items are shown & Not Specified. Please provide manufacturer & model #'s for pricing: Paper Towel Dispenser

3) Enlarged & interior plans do not show toilet tissue dispensers & seat cover dispensers. They are only shown in the ADA Stalls? Please confirm this is correct & they are NOT typical in all stalls for full coverage.

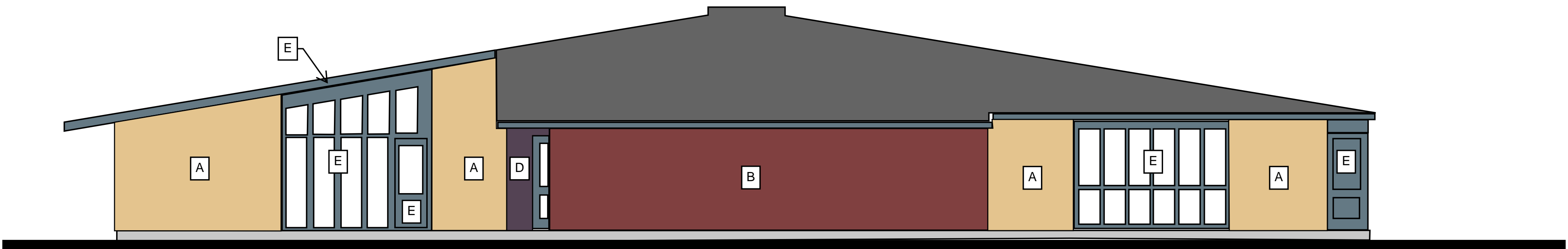

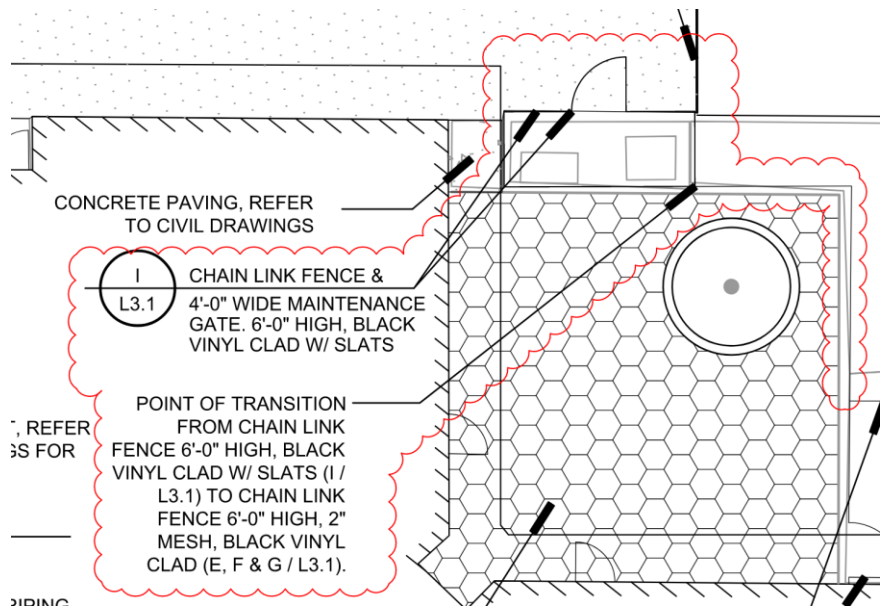
