2. The Project consists of:

Demolition and paveback of existing AC / base / concrete, grading, demolition of existing SD lines, installation of new SD lines, forming and pouring of new curbs and/or valley gutters, installation of new manhole(s) and/or DI(s). Engineer's Estimate: \$60,000.00

3. To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to possess one or more of the following State of California contractors' license(s):

A or B

The Bidder's license(s) must remain active and in good standing throughout the term of the Contract.

- 4. To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to be registered as a public works contractor with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to the Labor Code.
- 5. Contract Documents will be available on or after May 15th, 2023, and may be downloaded from the District's website, https://www.srcsbondprogram.org/domain/16, using the ["Doing Business With Us"] link.
- 6. San Rafael City Schools will only receive bids submitted electronically. Bids will be received until 2:30:00 p.m., June 6th, 2023, only at the following email address: Phyllis.silverstein@vpcsonline.com & cc'd to will@greystonewest.com after which time the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud via video conference. A link to the video conference will be provided by Addendum. Any bid that is submitted after this time shall be nonresponsive and returned to the bidder. Each bidder is solely responsible for timely submission of its bid; the District is not responsible for any technological issues in a bidder's ability to timely submit its bid or portion thereof. Any claim by a bidder of error in its bid must be made in compliance with section 5100 et seq. of the Public Contract Code. Prior to publicly reading aloud bids at the video conference, the District reserves the right to verify the genuineness of any bid security.
- 7. All bids shall be on the form provided by the District. Each bid must conform and be responsive to all pertinent Contract Documents, including, but not limited to, the Instructions to Bidders.
- 8. A bid bond by an admitted surety insurer on the form provided by the District a cashier's check or a certified check, drawn to the order of the San Rafael City

Schools, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid price, shall accompany the Bid Form and Proposal, as a guarantee that the Bidder will, within seven (7) calendar days after the date of the Notice of Award, enter into a contract with the District for the performance of the services as stipulated in the bid.

- 9. A mandatory pre-bid conference and site visit will be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 23rd</u>, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. at <u>San Rafael High School</u>, <u>150 3rd Street</u>, <u>San Rafael CA 94901</u>. All participants are required to sign in front of the <u>Madrone High School Building</u>, <u>San Rafael CA</u>. The site visit is expected to take approximately ½ hour. Failure to attend or tardiness will render bid ineligible. DO NOT ENTER ANY SCHOOL BUILDINGS.
- 10. The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond if it is awarded the Contract for the Work.
- 11. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.
- 12. The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all Work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to section 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. - 13. This Project is subject to labor compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.4 and subject to the requirements of Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations. The successful Bidder shall comply with all requirements of Division 2, Part 7, Chapter 1, Articles 1-5 of the Labor Code.
- 14. The District's Board has found and determined that the following item(s) shall be used on this Project based on the purpose(s) indicated. (Public Contract Code section 3400(c).) A particular material, product, thing, or service is designated by specific brand or trade name for the following purpose(s):
 - (1) In order to match other products in use on a particular public improvement either completed or in the course of completion:

- 15. The District shall award the Contract, if it awards it at all, to the lowest responsive responsible bidder based on:

- A. The base bid amount only.
