

San Rafael High School Community Notice

After nearly two years of construction, your Capital Facilities Team is excited to share that the work on the new main building at San Rafael High School is being completed during January and February. The new building will include new administration offices and an expanded student services area. The new Commons at the center of this building will provide a space for student gathering as well as a lunch space. Adjacent to the commons is the new central kitchen that supplies food to the entire district. The kitchen was completed in December and the kitchen staff started preparing and delivering food out of the new kitchen on January 5th. The building also includes the new Madrone School. The administration staff has moved into their new space and the school is being readied so that, when students can come back for in-person instruction, they will be in their exciting new space.

Starting in February, the old cafeteria and Madrone building will be demolished and construction of the new STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, & Math) building will start in the coming months. Construction of the new building will take approximately 16 months, and it will be ready for students at the start of the 22-23 school year.

This year will also see the remodel of the old admin offices in the AD building into five classrooms plus learning support spaces. Once that work is completed, San Rafael High School will have enough new classrooms so that the portables behind the gym can be removed from the campus.
