Terra Linda High School Gym + Frontage Update



To Our Nova Albion Way Neighbors,


We wanted to let you know that on October 10th the contractor building our new competition gymnasium will begin to construct the pedestrian safety improvements on the northeast side of Nova Albion Way, opposite the Terra Linda High School campus. The improvements include the construction of bulb outs at the crosswalks allowing access to the school campus across Nova Albion Way.

The bulb outs consist of ADA compliant ramps and tactile warning mats that transition the pedestrian sidewalk path to the crosswalks. On either side of the tactile warning strips in the crosswalk there are raised curbs and raised concrete areas that are approximately 6" above the street paving.


The bulb outs not only create a visual indication of the location of the crosswalks but are also effective traffic calming devices helping to slow vehicular traffic. The bulb outs occur in three locations. There's one at each end of El Pavo Real Circle and one mid-block opposite the main vehicular entrance to the campus.

We look forward to having these safety improvements completed making the pedestrian path of travel to Terra Linda High School much safer.


