Over the summer, the San Rafael City Schools' Capital Facilities Team was busy preparing for the new Student Commons Building (Library, Cafeteria, and Drama/Music Buildings). The Drama/Music Building was demolished, and underground utility infrastructure was installed in order to prevent disruptions to the campus during the academic year.

Preparations are underway to relocate the Library into a temporary space as the current Library will be converted to the Innovations Hub. Construction for this space is anticipated to start in January. We are awaiting the Division of the State Architect to complete their safety review of the Student Commons project for construction to start in March 2019. These new facilities will be exciting additions to the campus and will serve generations of students.

With dramatic increases in cost escalation construction pricing, we are working with Terra Linda High School's Site Design Committee to prioritize projects and provide updates on the next phases of work.
