Re: Sun Valley Construction Update

Dear Neighbors,

On behalf of the San Rafael City Schools (SRCS) Board of Education, we are excited to share that progress is underway on school bond Measures B & C, generously approved by voters in 2022 to update our facilities across the District.

As you are likely aware, SRCS is renovating the Sun Valley Elementary School campus as part of the bond work. Upgrades to the campus include adding a new three-classroom building for Transition Kindergarten (TK) classes; a new TK playground; two new shade structures; new planting; new fire department access lane; and accessibility improvements.



We are writing today to give notice that we will be removing bedrock in the areas shown to prepare for the new, widened fire department access lane. We want to especially bring to your attention that this demolition uses heavy equipment, and it will be noisy and could be unsettling.


We are intending to complete this work after school hours on Friday, Oct. 11 and throughout the day on Sat., Oct. 12. If necessary, we'll plan to complete the work on Monday, Oct. 14.

Unfortunately, we understand that construction of any nature can be disruptive, but we will make every effort to minimize the inconvenience to the surrounding community. In accordance with the City of San Rafael noise regulations, construction hours will be restricted to 7 am to 6 pm Monday through Friday and 9 am to 6 pm on Saturdays.
