Two Adjoining Projects, One Document

- Renovating Davidson Middle School, Laurel Dell Elementary School, with coordinated construction schedules and very close proximity.
- Evaluated potential environmental impacts of the projects with the Initial Study, and found that all were non-existent or could be mitigated to a less than significant level under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- Board will be asked tonight to approve the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) to allow construction to commence in a timely manner.

- Direct filing of Notice of Determination (starts 30 day challenge period)
